

ADOPTION OF SUBCOMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES AND ACTIONS

The written minutes of a subcommittee meeting and report to the full school committee shall be deemed received as an accurate record of the subcommittee meeting upon reading at a regular, adjourned regular or special meeting of the school committee. Any corrections to the contents of the minutes shall be made at the time of their reading or be deemed waived.

The adoption of subcommittee recommendations for action shall require an affirmative vote by the school committee to adopt the report. Should any committee member object to the adoption of the subcommittee meeting report in total, each action contained therein shall be considered separately by the school committee with a recorded vote on each separate recommendation.
