

ORGANIZATION OF INSTRUCTION

The School Committee is responsible for public education, pre-kindergarten through grade 12, throughout the city. It also assumes responsibility for adult education and special education.

The grouping and housing of instructional levels in the schools will be according to plans developed by the Superintendent and approved by the School Committee.

The currently approved organizations of instruction provide for the schools to be organized on the basis of grades Pre-K, K-5, 6-8, 9-12. Certain exceptions to this general rule may be made with the approval of the School Committee.
