

SUMMER SCHOOL

The Westfield School Committee provides the opportunity for students to participate in a variety of summer courses for credit, improvement, and enrichment. These summer programs have been designed to:

- Provide the student who is passing, but needs improvement, with the opportunity to acquire basic skills and increase the base of knowledge in a specific academic area in preparation for the following year.
- Give the student who wants to expand in an area of interest a meaningful summer enrichment experience.
- Allow the student who has not met academic requirements an opportunity to make up deficiencies and establish credit in specific subjects.
- Students who are determined by school authorities to need summer school will be contacted by the guidance office. Anyone taking a course for credit must obtain permission from the proper authority in his/her school. To receive credit for a summer school course the student must meet both academic and attendance requirements.

The Westfield School Committee expects all students to comply with the same general rules of conduct as outlined in the school handbooks for the regular school year.

Summer school programs are not considered to be extended school year services, as that term is used under special education laws.
