

TARDINESS

Students are expected to arrive at school and to class on time. Students who demonstrate a pattern of unexcused tardiness may be subject to disciplinary measures.

Time missed from class constitutes absenteeism, whether in part or in whole. Therefore, at the high school level, class time missed due to unexcused tardiness may be accrued for the purpose of determining loss of credit in accordance with the district's policy for Student Attendance, Absences, and Excuses.
