

PUBLIC INFORMATION PROGRAM

The people in this community are interested in their schools as an extension of their homes, existing to furnish a special form of aid in the development of their children. The schools closely touch the lives of all persons in this community, and every attempt shall be made by the school committee to represent the people according to the best interests of their children. To this end, the school committee shall attempt to:

1. Keep themselves and the public informed regarding the policies, administration operation, objectives, and successes or failures of the schools.
2. Provide the means for furnishing full and accurate information, favorable and unfavorable, together with interpretation and explanation of the school plans and programs.
