

COMMERICAL ACTIVITIES

The Westfield Public Schools is committed to providing an orderly and efficient school environment conducive to learning. To that end, the school district prohibits the distribution of commercial products and/or commercial solicitation on school grounds or at any school-sponsored activity except as provided for in this policy.

For purposes of this policy, the following definitions apply:

Commercial means anything related to a for-profit organization or enterprise.

Commercial Solicitation is defined as the sale, or offer for sale, of any property or service. It also includes any request for funds or donation, whether direct or indirect.

The distribution of commercial products and commercial solicitation may be permitted if authorized in connection with a school-sponsored activity or organization, provided that a building administrator has granted permission for such activity.
