School Building Committee

The city may create a school building committee for specific building projects. These committees act as the administrative authority for the projects, subject to approval of various actions by the school committee and city.

The school building committee has the following responsibilities:

1. To study and make recommendations to the city with respect to school building needs.
2. To review thoroughly with the superintendent and the school committee the educational requirements in relation to school buildings.
3. To review previous studies and initiate need studies with or without consultative assistance.
4. To employ the service of architects and cost estimators and such other professional assistance as it may deem necessary.
