

QUORUM

A simple majority of school committee members will constitute a quorum unless otherwise provided by general or special law, executive order or other authorizing provision.

The Attorney General may, by regulation or letter ruling, authorize remote participation by members of the School Committee not present at the meeting location, provided however, that the absent member and all persons present at the meeting location are clearly audible to each other and provided further, that a quorum of the body including the chair are present at the meeting location. Such authorized members may vote.
